Mazie Lee Mackbee was born in Brookhaven, Mississippi to the union of Henry and Rosetta (Saunders) Dixon on August 11, 1928. She was the seventh child of eight children. Mazie was affectionately known as granny, mama, and moms to many who knew her. She met her husband, James at a social club in 1947 in Brookhaven and they married that same year. To this union five children were born. In 1951 she and two of her children joined her husband in Vallejo. He had migrated to California from Mississippi for better employment opportunities.
